#### PARTICIPANT GUIDELINES

**Purpose:** The original intention of this exhibition was to celebrate the recent creative work of Gallery members. Uh oh 2020! Our Present Tense situation requires a new purpose: an end of year boost of sales to support local artists and our community's public art gallery.

**Eligibility:** Entry into the exhibition is open to all members of the Gibsons Public Art Gallery. Members are invited to submit one original piece for this show. All work included in the exhibition must be listed for sale. The Gallery will take a 30% sales commission (or higher for artists in a position to donate sale proceeds in support of local public art programs). Please price your work accordingly. Works will be on display for the duration of the exhibition, although exceptions will be made to facilitate sales of art.

**Creative Work:** This exhibition is for all artists/makers/creative people in all mediums. Paintings, photographs, drawings, prints, mixed media, sculpture, fibre arts, wood work.  
All creative work!

**Registration: DEADLINE is 4 PM Sunday, November 29th;** Please deliver your completed submission form to the Gallery with your ready to install work. Artists are welcome to include an artist statements and bio with their submission. Supporting material will be displayed in a binder in the Gallery during the exhibition.

**Fees:** Exhibition participants must be current members of the Gallery. Individual memberships are \$20 (\$35 for a family of 4) and can be purchased at the Gallery or online at [www.gpag.ca/become-a-member](http://www.gpag.ca/become-a-member).

**Deliver work to the Gallery** between November 26<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup>, 11 AM and 4 PM; or contact the Gallery to make alternate arrangements. Two-dimensional work must be **ready to hang** with proper and secure hanging hardware. Please affix identification labeling to the reverse of your work (as described in the registration form).

**Exhibition Hours:** The exhibition will be open Thursday through Monday, 11 AM to 4 PM.

**Security:** Every precaution is taken to ensure the safety of the works on exhibition, but insurance is the responsibility of the artist. GPAG will not assume responsibility for loss due to theft, damage or other causes.

**Pick up of work:** Unsold works can be picked up Sunday December 20<sup>th</sup> at 4pm or contact the Gallery to make alternate arrangements.
