



GPAG MEMBERS EXHIBITION PRESENT TENSE 2021: DECEMBER 2 – 19

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

The purpose of this exhibition is to celebrate the recent creative work of our Gallery members, and provide an end of year art sales opportunity for our artist members and our work as a public art gallery.

Eligibility: Entry into the exhibition is open to all members of the Gibsons Public Art Gallery. Members are invited to submit one recent original creation. Please affix identification labeling to the reverse of your work (as described in the registration form). Two-dimensional work must be **ready to hang** with proper and secure hanging hardware. This is a GPAG public art fundraiser, and work submitted in the exhibition should be listed for sale. **The Gallery will take a 30% sales commission** (or optionally higher for artists in a position to donate further commission proceeds to support GPAG). Please price your work accordingly. It is expected that works will be on display for the duration of the exhibition, but exceptions will be made to facilitate sales.

Creative Work: This exhibition is open to all artists/makers/creative people in all mediums! Paintings, photographs, drawings, prints, mixed media, sculpture, fiber arts, wood work. All creative work is welcome! Questions about suitability of works for submission can be directed to info@gpag.ca.

Registration: DEADLINE is 4 PM Sunday, November 28th. Please deliver your completed submission form to the Gallery with your ready to install work.

Fees: Exhibition participants must be current members of the Gallery. Individual memberships are \$20 (\$35 for a family of 4) and can be purchased at the Gallery or online at www.gpag.ca/become-a-member.

Deliver work to the Gallery with the submission form between November 25-28th, 11 AM and 4 PM; or contact the Gallery to make alternate arrangements.

Exhibition Hours: The exhibition will be open Thursday through Monday, 11 AM to 4 PM.

Security: Every precaution is taken to ensure the safety of the works on exhibition, but insurance is the responsibility of the artist. GPAG will not assume responsibility for loss due to theft, damage or other causes.

Pick up of work: Unsold works can be picked up Sunday December 19th at 4pm, or contact the Gallery to make alternate arrangements.
